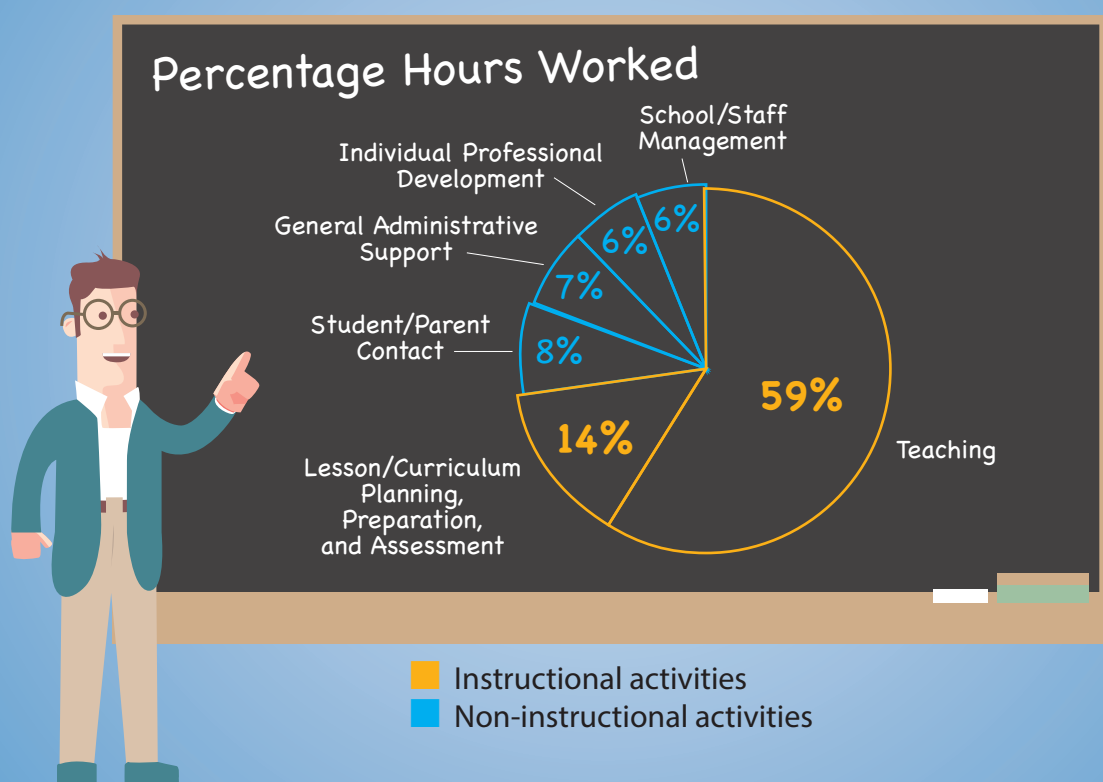


Teachers work about 1540 hours on average worldwide

Productive Time

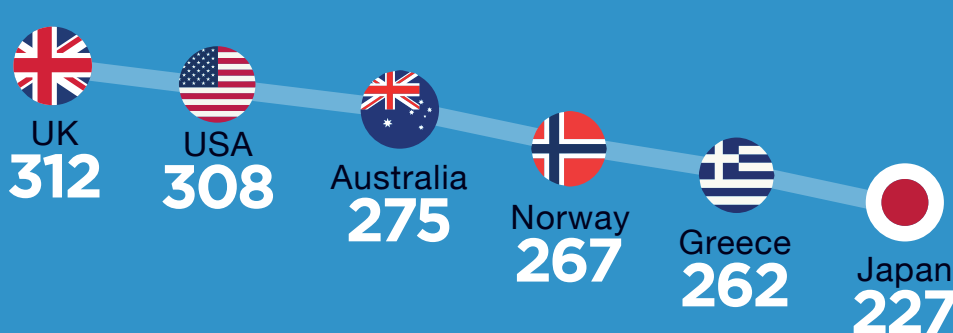
Productivity vs. Inefficiency

Across all activities, teachers describe a big portion of their work as “inefficient.”

Teachers estimate about one full work day per week per teacher is wasted.

That's 306 hours per year!
